SIXTEENTH ANNUAL JOINT ACADEMY GOLF OUTING Monday, August 18, 2008

The West Point Society of New England will again sponsor this year's golf outing for graduates, family, and friends of West Point, Navy, Coast Guard, Merchant Marine, and Air Force Academies.

Forty-six graduates, friends and family participated last year. Fifteen twosomes played for Army, five for Navy, and three for the Coast Guard. The Coast Guard continued their dominance of the Challenge Trophy by winning with a young twosome, Andy Clyburn and Dave Bickel, both class of '92 taking the trophy from last year's winners, Dave Fuka '84 and Jim Sherrard '64, who placed second. Third place was won by the Navy team of Kevin Clancy '69 and Jim Matheson '87. Army honor was upheld by Biff Shea '85, who won the Individual Champion Trophy handily. Army muscle was demonstrated by Rich Sheridan '90 for the longest drive for men, and by Tara Miller '87, longest drive for women. Chris Dunphy, Navy '87 had the straightest drive for men, and Kathleen Sherman, Army '87 for women. Andy Clyburn, Coast Guard '92, was closest to the pin on hole #13 at 38" while Jim Matheson, Navy '87, landed 5'11" from the pin on hole #3. Everyone got a prize according to demonstrated prowess or seniority at the 19th hole. A great time was had by all, everyone saying they would be back next year and would bring more graduates and friends.

Registration begins at 0730. Shotgun start begins promptly at 0830.

Two-person teams will choose one of the following formats of play for their team:
A. Nine holes of scramble and nine holes of best ball, declared hole by hole by each team after all golfers in the foursome have hit their tee shots,
Best Ball for all 18 holes (team will be awarded bonus points), or
Scramble for all 18 holes (team will have points deducted).

Notes:

1. Competition for the CHALLENGE TROPHY will be limited to teams consisting of graduates of the same academy.
2. The New England 2007 Service Academy INDIVIDUAL CHAMPION TROPHY will be awarded to the academy graduate scoring the most points playing the Best Ball format.
3. All other competition and recognition (2nd & 3rd place for trophies, longest drive & closest-to-pin) will be available to all golfers and teams.

Cost will be \$90 for each player, which includes green fees, driving range, riding cart (w/GPS), prizes, and an issue Mulligan. Additional mulligans can be procured for \$5 each for one or two mulligans. The club house has food and beverages available (no host).
