

Joint Service Academy Golf Outing 2007

Forty-six graduates of the Army, Navy, and Coast Guard Academies, friends and family braved the very hot weather to participate in this 16th annual outing at one of New England's premier golf courses, Blackstone National Golf Club in Sutton, MA. Fifteen twosomes played for Army, five for Navy, and three for the Coast Guard. The Coast Guard continued their dominance of the Challenge Trophy by winning with a young twosome, Andy Clyburn and Dave Bickel, both class of '92 taking the trophy from last year's winners, Dave Fuka '84 and Jim Sherrard '64, who placed second. Third place was won by the Navy team of Kevin Clancy '69 and Jim Matheson '87. Army honor was upheld by Biff Shea '85, who won the Individual Champion Trophy handily.

Army muscle was demonstrated by Rich Sheridan '90 for the longest drive for men, and by Tara Miller '87, longest drive for women. Chris Dunphy, Navy '87 had the straightest drive for men, and Kathleen Sherman, Army '87 for women. Andy Clyburn, Coast Guard '92, was closest to the pin on hole #13 at 38" while Jim Matheson, Navy '87, landed 5'11" from the pin on hole #3.

Everyone got a prize according to demonstrated prowess or seniority at the 19th hole. A great time was had by all, everyone saying they would be back next year and would bring more graduates and friends.
